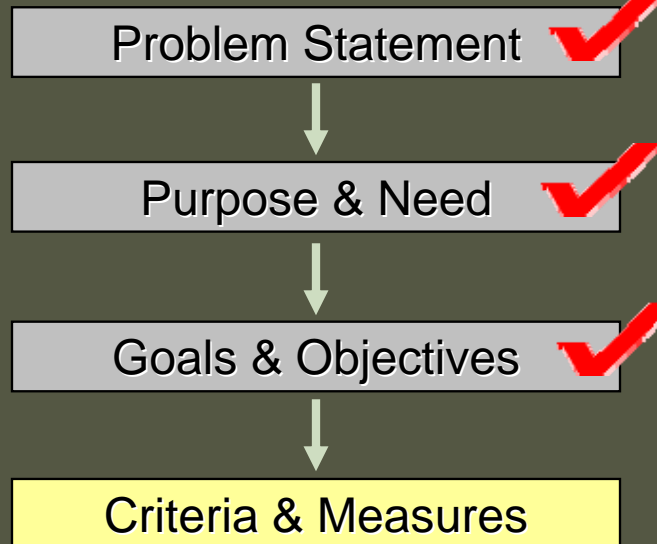

Criteria & Measures Development



Purpose of Criteria & Measures

- Criteria and Measures used to
 - Evaluate alternatives
 - Identify most promising or viable alternatives
 - Select alternatives
- Allows interested parties to
 - Compare and rank alternatives
 - Determine what alternatives best meet project Purpose and Need / Goals and Objectives

Evaluation

- Criteria will be used at three levels
 - Fatal Flaw
 - Screening
 - Alternatives Analysis



Approach

- Criteria fall into 4 categories
 - Planning
 - Community
 - Regulatory
 - Engineering

Criteria Questionnaire

- Criteria reflect all the project goals and objectives
- Questionnaire will help show the relative importance of each criterion to the community
- Your input will be considered along with the technical team, agencies, PRC, etc.



Criteria Questionnaire

- Consider how project alternatives might effect the community
- Add any fatal flaw issues we should consider
- Have we missed anything?
 - Add any criteria that may be missing that address the goals and objectives
