### **Public invited to Oct. 19 open house to comment on proposed Harmony Road, Sunnybrook Boulevard projects**

The Clackamas County Department of Transportation and Development is beginning a process to increase safety and reduce congestion along Harmony Road. Two major projects are involved – Harmony Road Environmental Assessment (EA) and Sunnybrook Boulevard Extension.

The public is invited to learn more about and comment on the projects at an open house scheduled from 6-8 p.m., Thursday, October 19, 2006. The open house will be held in room 178 at the Oregon Institute of Technology (OIT) campus at 7726 SE Harmony Road in Milwaukie.

“This is a great opportunity for the community to provide direct feedback to the project team,” said Ron Weinman, Clackamas County Project Manager for Harmony Road. “The ideas, comments and concerns we hear will be addressed as we review and develop options for the long-term realignment of Harmony Road and Sunnybrook Boulevard.”

The October 19th open house will include information and discussion about:

- The project limits and the affected project area for both Harmony Road and Sunnybrook Boulevard;
- The Harmony Road project development process, including preparing an Environmental Assessment;
- The Harmony Road preliminary goals and objectives.

More open houses are planned in the coming year to give the public a continuing opportunity to learn about and comment on the projects as they develop.
